carry out various duties and responsibilities in line with that of an independent clinician, including 20-24 direct patient hours per week (individual & family therapy), running 2-3 advanced trauma groups for survivors of sexual abuse, facilitating 'meal support therapy' with my individual patients, case supervision, peer supervision, full case management of my patients, clinical patient rounds, clinical staff meetings and general milieu management as needed.
